

WA State Averages Calculations

The following applies to all state averages calculation for Men Paxton averages only:-

- The averages are open to all male amateur golfers resident in Western Australia with an Australian handicap of five (5) or less
- To qualify for the Paxton Averages, a player must play a minimum of fifteen (15) rounds in the scheduled events
- Players withdrawing or disqualified from a round will have a score of eight six (86) recorded for that round (except in circumstances that are approved by Golf Western Australia)
- Scores returned during an event where the Australian Course Rating is below 71 will be increased or decreased by the number of strokes by which the rating is below or above 71.
- Once a player has completed fifteen rounds the worst score of the player shall be excluded and thereafter one round for every fifteen played shall be excluded
- The winner of the Paxton Averages will be the player who has the lowest adjusted score for the year

The following applies to all state averages calculation for Women Ivie Temperley averages only:-

- The averages are open to all female amateur golfers resident in Western Australia with an Australian handicap of fifteen (15) or less
- To qualify for the Ivie Temperley Averages, a player must play a minimum of fifteen (15) rounds in the scheduled events
- Players withdrawing or disqualified from a round will have a score of eight six (86) recorded for that round (except in circumstances that are approved by Golf Western Australia)
- Scores returned during an event where the Australian Course Rating is below 71 will be increased or decreased by the number of strokes by which the rating is below or above 71.
- Once a player has completed fifteen rounds (15) the worst score of the player shall be excluded and thereafter one round for every fifteen (15) played shall be excluded
- The winner of the Ivie Temperley Averages will be the player who has the lowest adjusted score for the year

The following applies to all state averages calculation for Smarter than Smoking Junior averages only:-

- The averages are open to all boys and girls amateur golfers resident in Western Australia. There is no minimum handicap requirement.
- To qualify for the Smarter than Smoking Junior Averages, a player must play a minimum of fifteen (15) rounds in the scheduled events
- Players withdrawing or disqualified from a round will have a score of ninety two (92) recorded for that round (except in circumstances that are approved by Golf Western Australia)
- Scores returned during an event where the Australian Course Rating is below 71 will be increased or decreased by the number of strokes by which the rating is below or above 71.
- Once a player has completed fifteen (15) rounds the worst score of the player shall be excluded and thereafter one round for every fifteen (15) played shall be excluded
- The winner of the Smarter than Smoking Junior Averages in their respective age division will be the player who has returned the lowest adjusted score for the year.
