CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. ELIGIBILITY
The event is open to male and female amateur golfers who have an official GA Handicap.
2. MATCH COMMITTEE
 - 2.1 The Club Match Committee will have sole management and control of the event.
 - 2.2 In the absence of the full Club Match Committee, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full committee.
 - 2.3 The Match Committee's decision on matters affecting the event will be final.
 - 2.4 The decision of the Club Match Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.
3. RULES OF PLAY
The Rules of Golf, as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Rules Limited, will apply together with the Local Rules of Hartfield Country Club.
4. ENTRIES
 - 4.1 Entries will be subject to the approval of the entrant's home club.
 - 4.2 Entrants must conform in all aspects to the Rules of Amateur Status, as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Rules Limited.
 - 4.3 A fully completed entry form together with the applicable entry fee must be received no later than 10th September 2018.
 - 4.4 In the event of entries exceeding the number of places available, entries from public course entrants will be balloted out and then higher handicap competitors. Unsuccessful entrants will be given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Entrance fees will be refunded to entrants balloted out, who do not compete.
 - 4.5 Entrance fees will only be refunded in the case of a withdrawal being received 24 hours prior the first round.
 - 4.6 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the committee.
5. THE EVENT
 - 5.1 The event will be played over 36 holes of stroke play for A Grade Hcp 0-10
And 36 Holes Stableford B Grade HCP 11-19 & C Grade 20+ .
 - 5.2 The schedule of the event will be as follows –
Round One will be played on Saturday 15th September 2018.
Round Two will be played on Sunday 16th September 2018.
- NB. Players eligible for the Paxton Averages will play on the same side of the draw.
- 5.3 Sunday - alternate tees and time.
- 5.4 In the event of there being a tie for the overall gross winner of the event, a sudden death playoff will take place to determine the winner. All other ties will be decided by using the Australian Count Back System.
6. PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT
All entrants assent to be bound by the Golf WA's Code of Conduct. A copy of the code is available at www.golfwa.org.au/guests/about/policies/codesofconduct.mhtml
7. TEE OFF TIMES
Rule 6-3a provides: "The player shall start at the time laid down by the committee". The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However it is a condition of this event that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if a player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes of his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes in stroke play rounds.
8. MOTORISED CARTS
The Golf WA's policy on the use of motorized golf carts will be enforced for the duration of the event. A copy of the policy is available at www.golfwa.org.au/guests/about/policies/motorisedcarts.mhtml
9. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES
In this competition, a player *may* obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a *stipulated round*, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.
10. PRACTICE
One complimentary practice round will be provided on Friday 14th September to players eligible for the Paxton Averages. **Bookings to be made through the Pro Shop – Ph. No. 9453 9194**
11. DRESS REGULATION
The following dress regulations will be enforced during the event –
ON COURSE: Collared Shirt (tucked in), Tailored shorts or pants to be worn with a belt, socks and soft spiked golf shoes. CLUBHOUSE: Golf attire is allowed.
