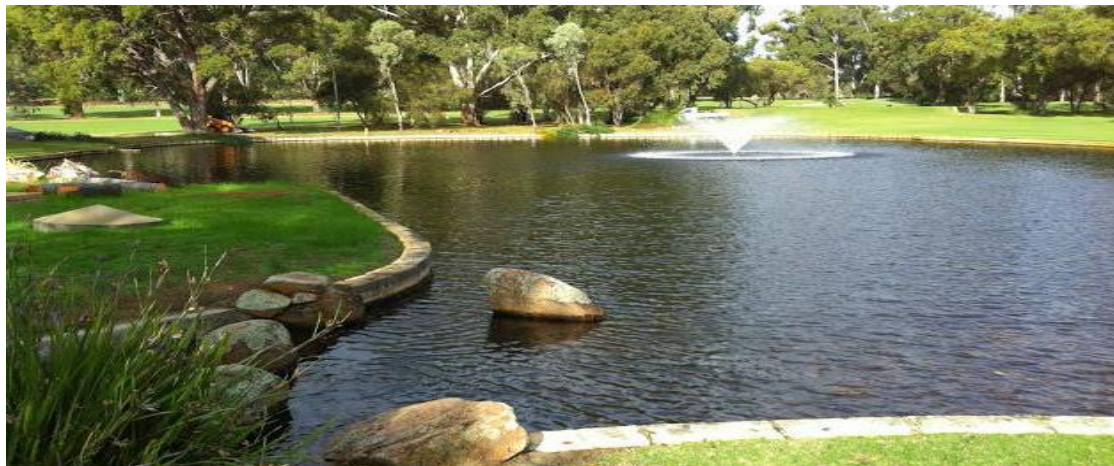

Open to Senior Male Amateurs of Affiliated Clubs who are 55 years of age or over as at the 15th October 2018, upon receipt of a completed entry form accompanied by payment details.

DRESS CODE

In keeping with current day dress sense, the Wanneroo Golf Club has a relaxed approach to attire on and off the golf course. **Basically the code is self-governing.** Members, their guests and visitors are asked to dress in a **CLEAN, NEAT** and **TIDY** fashion. Fashion on the course is dictated by golf fashion at the time.

JEANS: Denim Jeans or shorts are **NOT PERMITTED** to be worn on the course. Denim Jeans are acceptable off the course providing jeans do not have holes, patches or shredded edges. Jeans **must** be of high quality.

SHORTS: Shorts must have a belt (not draw string) and should be of good quality. Preferably, socks worn with shorts should be predominantly white.

GOLF SHIRTS: Golf Shirts may be worn outside of the shorts on the course. Dress Shirts in the lounge may be worn outside trousers, as fashion dictates.

GOLF SHOES: Golf Shoes **ARE NOT PERMITTED** to be worn in the lounge area. Covered shoes are to be worn in the lounge area. This does not include sneakers, sandshoes and sandals of any type. Away from the lounge, additional relaxation allows casual footwear or neat, clean golf attire.

LUNCH AND REFRESHMENTS

Lunch and refreshments will be available for purchase in the Clubhouse.

The draw will be published on the Golf WA and WGC websites by Thursday 11th October 2018.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. All players must be male amateurs who have attained the age of **55 years** as at 15th October 2018.
2. 18 Hole competition to be played on Monday 15th October 2018, at 11.30 am.
A Grade will play Stroke competition from the White Tees (Slope 123).
B and C grade will play Stableford competition from the White Tees (Slope 123).
Major Prizes to include: Best Gross, Runner up Gross & Best Nett (A Grade); 1st & 2nd Nett in B & C Grades; and NTPs. Prizes may be varied at the discretion of the Committee. Players may only win 1 major prize.
3. Grades are ascertained according to GA Handicaps as follows:
A Grade: 9.6 and below (daily H/C 10 and below)
B Grade: 9.7 to 18.8 (daily H/C 11 to 20)
C Grade: 18.9 and above (daily H/C 21 and above)
4. Entries must be made on the official entry form (attached and available on the WGC website) and accompanied by the entrance fee of \$30.00 for visitors and \$15.00 for WGC members. No refunds will be given once the draw has been published.
5. All competitors shall be under the control of the Match Committee, who shall have the power to:-
 - (a) Draw competitors in such manner as thought advisable;
 - (b) Vary the conditions of play or Handicap Grades as may be deemed advisable;
 - (c) Refuse the entry of any person;
 - (d) Decide the method to be employed in the case of ties;
 - (e) Penalise any competitor for slow play;
 - (f) Accept late entries; and
 - (g) Invite any person to compete in the tournament.
6. The Match Committee will decide all disputes. Protests must be advised verbally to the Tournament Office immediately upon completion of the round in which the incident occurred and confirmed in writing to the Match Committee within 20 minutes. All ties will be decided by countback method.
7. The use of Distance Measuring Devices is allowed.
8. All players may ride in a motorised cart. All carts must comply with WGC regulations. A limited number of carts are available for hire. Contact the Pro Shop for cart bookings. Players who wish to use a cart will be drawn in the same group where possible.
9. Players are to report to the Pro Shop and swipe their Golflink Card before play commences. Players must arrive at their allocated starting tee at least 5 minutes before their appointed starting time. Breach of this condition will be penalised under rule 6-3(a).
10. Score Cards signed by the Marker and countersigned by the Player must be returned to the Tournament Office immediately upon completion of the round. Breach of this condition may mean disqualification.
11. Entries will be accepted up until 1.00 pm on Wednesday 10th October 2018.
12. The Committee reserves the right to ballot out players in the event of a capacity field.
