CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. The Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews shall apply together with the Local Rules as drawn up by the Open Committee.
2. The Championship Committee:
 - 2.1 The Championship Committee will consist of the Chairperson of the GolfWA Management Committee, members of the Golf Management Committee, the Golf Operations Manager together with any members of the host club that may be co-opted to serve on the Championship Committee.
 - 2.2 The Championship Committee reserves the right to vary any of the Championship Conditions.
 - 2.3 In the absence of the full Championship Committee, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision and any decision so given shall be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Committee.
3. Entry fees will not be refunded after the draw has been posted on the web.
4. Tee Off Times:

Rule 6-3a provides: "The player shall start at the time laid down by the Committee." The penalty for the breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However it is a condition of this Championship that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if the player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes in stroke play rounds and loss of the first hole in match play rounds, instead of disqualification."
5. Motorised Golf Carts:

The Golf WA motorized golf policy will apply. Copies of this are available from the Golf WA Office or on the website, www.golfwa.org.au
6. The whole course and club house are SMOKE FREE.
7. Open to full playing Amateur Lady Members of Golf Clubs affiliated with GA and Clubs recognized by the Bodies governing Women's Golf in overseas countries.
8. Players must comply with the dress regulations of the host club.
9. Drug Testing:

All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Drug Agency for banned substances as laid down in the Golf Australia Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy or refusing to take a test may be disqualified. A copy of the policy is available at www.golfaustralia.org.au
10. Player Code of Conduct
All entrants assent to be bound by the GolfWA Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available on the GolfWA website www.golfwa.org.au
11. All ties will be decided by a countback.
12. The audible use of mobile phones is not allowed on the course or in the clubhouse.
13. Measuring Devices:

Devices measuring "distance only" will be permitted during the event.
