# 2014 MELVILLE GLADES GOLF CLUB

## SENIOR AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP

### 1. Eligibility

1.1 Any amateur male golfer who has attained the age of fifty-five on the 14th day of October 2014.

1.2 Each competitor must be a member of a Metropolitan or Country Club and hold a current GA handicap. Overseas entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Championship Committee.

### 2. The Championship

2.1 The Championship will be played over 18 holes. The winner of the Championship will be the player who records the lowest eighteen hole gross score. In the event of a tie for the winner a sudden death play off will occur.

2.2 Play will be conducted in three divisions and the divisions will be divided equally upon receipt of entries.

A grade will play stroke while B & C grade will play a Stableford event

In the event of a tie for the Gross championship winner a sudden death play off will occur. In the case of other ties the Australian Countback System will be used.

### 3. Trophies

3.1 Trophies will be awarded for the following:

**Championship (A)** Overall Gross Winner and Runner Up  
Overall Nett Winner and Runner Up

**Senior Stableford (B & C)** Winner and Runner Up – each grade

#### Nearest the Pins – All Grades

### 4. Field Size

The overall field size will be restricted to one hundred and twenty players. Should entries exceed this number then players will be balloted from the Championship commencing with the highest handicapped players.

### 5. Motorised Golf Carts

Only players with approved medical certificates are eligible to utilise a motorised cart.

### 6. Player Code of Conduct

All entrants assent to be bound by the Golf WA Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available at [www.golfwa.org.au](http://www.golfwa.org.au)

### 7. The Championship Committee

7.1 The Championship Committee will consist of the Captain of Melville Glades Golf Club and members of the MGGC Match Committee.

7.2 The Championship Committee reserves the right to vary any of the Championship Conditions.

7.3 In the absence of the full Championship Committee, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision and any decision so given shall be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Committee.

### 8. GPS Measuring Devices

The use of Measuring Devices is permitted in conjunction with the Rules of Golf.
