CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. Handicapping:
Should a player's handicap increase or decrease either side of the limit after entering the player should play off her revised handicap.
Players will retain the same handicap for the 36 holes.
2. No player may win more than one nett trophy (excluding teams' events and NTP's).
3. Entry fees are forfeited and non transferable once the draw has been finalised.
4. Entry fees and dinner money must accompany the entry form.
5. The Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews shall apply together with the Local Rules as drawn up by the Golf Management Committee.
6. The Golf Management Committee reserves the right to vary any of the Conditions.
7. Motorised Golf Carts:
The Golf WA motorized golf policy will apply. Copies of this are available from the Golf WA website, www.golfwa.org.au
8. The whole course and club house are SMOKE FREE.
9. Open to full playing Amateur Lady Members of Golf Clubs affiliated with GA and Clubs recognized by the Bodies governing Women's Golf in overseas countries.
10. Drug Testing:
All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Drug Agency for banned substances as laid down in the Golf Australia Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy or refusing to take a test may be disqualified. A copy of the policy is available at www.golfaustralia.org.au
11. Player Code of Conduct
All entrants assent to be bound by the GolfWA Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available on the GolfWA website www.golfwa.org.au
12. All ties will be decided by a countback.
13. Measuring Devices:
Devices measuring "distance only" will be permitted during this championship. "In this competition, a player **may** obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a *stipulated round*, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used".
14. The audible or unauthorized use of mobile phones is not permitted on course or clubhouse.

NOTE: If 2 fields. Gladys Hawkes Shield Teams Event – Best 2 scores from a club from both competitions.
