**CONDITIONS OF PLAY**

Open to all amateur golfers (male) who must be a member of an affiliated club; A, B or C grade. Entrants must have an approved Golf Australia handicap and provide their Golf Link Number.

The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and Local Rules of the Gosnells Golf Club.

The Match Committee of the Club is in charge of the competition and:

A. The match committee reserve the right to ballot players if necessary and accept or refuse any entry.

B. In the event of a tie. - First Gross ties for event will be played on a sudden death basis using holes numbers 1 & 9. All other ties to be decided by count back method.

C. A player is only eligible to win one trophy

D. Reserves the right to vary playing conditions in any way found necessary.
