Conditions of Entry

1. ELIGIBILITY

- 1.1 The event is open to male and female amateur golfers under the age of 18 years as at 1 January 2014 with a registered Golf Australia handicap of 27 for less or boys and 30 or less girls.

2. MATCH COMMITTEE

- 2.1 The Club Match Committee will have sole management and control of the event.
- 2.2 In the absence of the full Club Match Committee, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full committee.
- 2.3 The Match Committee's decision on matters affecting the event will be final. Protests must be made in writing and submitted to the Match Committee within 10 minutes of the conclusion of the days play.
- 2.4 The decision of the Club Match Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.
- 2.5 The Match Committee has the right to shorten the event in the case of inclement or extreme weather.

3. RULES OF PLAY

- 3.1 The Rules of Golf, as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Rules Limited, will apply together with the Local Rules of the club.

4. ENTRIES

- 4.1 Entries will be subject to the approval of the entrant's home club.
- 4.2 Entrants must conform in all aspects to the Rules of Amateur Status, as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Rules Limited.
- 4.3 A fully completed entry form together with the applicable entry fee must be lodged no later than 15 May.
- 4.4 In the event of entries exceeding the number of places available (84), entries from those higher handicap competitors will be decided by ballot. Unsuccessful entrants will be given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Entrance fees will be refunded to entrants balloted out who do not compete.
- 4.5 Entrance fees will only be refunded in the case of a withdrawal being received 72 hours prior to the event.
- 4.6 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the committee. Any such entry shall be subject to the application of a \$10.00 late fee (includes GST).

5. THE EVENT

- 5.1 The event will be played over 36 holes of stroke play.
- 5.2 The draw will be published by 4pm on Friday 23 May 2014.
- 5.3 In the event of there being a tie for the overall gross male winner or female winner of the event, a sudden death playoff will take place to determine the winner. All other ties will be decided by using the Australian Count Back System.

6. PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

- 6.1 All entrants assent to be bound by the Golf WA Code of Conduct. A copy of the code is available at http://golfwa.org.au/upload/wysiwyg/about_policies_policymanual/GolfWA%20Member%20Protection%20Policy.pdf.

7. MOTORISED CARTS

8. DRESS REGULATION

- 8.1 The following dress regulations will be enforced during the event for both Players and Caddies:
 - **Boys:** Long trousers, tailored shorts with short all white socks that cover the ankle. Secret/hidden socks may not be worn. Shorts must not be below the knee, shirts must have collars and be tucked into waistband. No cargo style shorts or trousers, no jeans.
 - **Girls:** Golf skirt, slacks, Bermuda length shorts. No cargo style shorts or trousers, no jeans.

In the Clubhouse:

- **Boys:** Long trousers, tailored shirt tucked into waistband, street shoes.
- **Girls:** Neat casual (other than golf attire), street shoes.
