1. Eligibility

1.1 Any amateur male golfer who has attained the age of fifty years of age on the first day of the event.

1.2 Each competitor:

a. must be a member of a club affiliated with Golf WA and hold a current Australian handicap; or,

b. if from another state, must be a member of a club affiliated with the applicable state body and hold a current Australian handicap; or,

c. if from overseas, entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Championship Committee.

2. The Championships

2.1 The Four Ball Championship shall be played over 36 holes, in pairs over 2 consecutive days. The first round shall be played on Thursday 4th September 2014 and the final round on Friday 5th September 2014. The winners of the championship shall be the pair who scores the highest Nett Stableford score over 36 holes. In the event of a tie for the Championship, and for all Trophies, the Australian Count back Systems will be used.

2.2 The maximum permitted individual handicap shall be 36 and play will be conducted in 3 Divisions approximately as follows:

a. A Grade **b.** B Grade **c.** C Grade

The three divisions will be decided upon receipt of all entries.

2.3 Gross Scores will be determined by using half of the competitors combined handicaps. This handicap will be deducted from the Stableford total to give a Stableford Gross score.

3. Trophies

3.1 Major Trophies. Trophies will be awarded for the following:

State Champions Best Nett Score from any Grade.

Best Gross Best Gross score from any Grade.

A Grade: Winners Best Nett score from this Grade.

Runners Up Best Nett score from this Grade.

B Grade: Winners Best Nett score from this Grade.

Runners Up Best Nett score from this Grade.

C Grade: Winners Best Nett score from this Grade.

Runners Up Best Nett score from this Grade.

Thursday and Friday winners and runners up in all grades

3.2 No players will be allowed to win more than one major trophy.

3.3 There will be novelties on all Par 3 holes on each day.

4. Field Size. The overall field size may be restricted. Should entries be restricted, pairs of players will be balloted from the Championship commencing with the latest entries received. That is selection will be on first come first served basis. Field size may cause there to be an **AM** and **PM** round.

5. Motorised Golf Carts. The Golf WA Motorised golf cart policy is in effect for this event. Details are available from Golf WA website.

6. The Championship Committee

6.1 The event will be under the control of the Championship Committee of Kwinana Golf Club, which conduct the event on behalf of and under the auspices of Golf WA

6.2 The Championship Committee will have the final say on any decision or dispute.

6.3 The Championship Committee reserves the right to vary any of the Championship conditions.
