## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

**TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE:** The Tournament Committee shall comprise the Tournament Officer, Junior Council Delegate and members of the Club Match Committee. In the absence of the full committee, such members as thereof may be present at any time may give a decision and any decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Tournament Committee. The Tournament Committee shall have the sole management and control of the tournament with full power at any time to alter or vary any of the conditions.

**ELIGIBILITY:** The event is open to all amateur golfers 18 years of age and under as at the 2nd March 2015. Players who do not possess an official Australian Handicap will only be eligible to win a gross trophy.

**RULES:** The rules of golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and such local rules as are in force on the course over which the tournament is being played will apply. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Tournament Committee whose decision shall be final.

**PROTESTS:** The Tournament Committee's decision on matters affecting the tournament shall be final. Protests must be made in writing and submitted to the Committee within 10 minutes of the conclusion of the day's play.

**TEE-OFF TIMES:** Rule 6-3a provides "The player shall start at the time laid down by the Committee." The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However it is a condition of this tournament that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if the player arrives at his/her starting point ready to play, within five minutes of his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes.

**ENTRIES:** The Tournament Committee reserves the right in special circumstances to accept late entries after the closing date. Fees must be paid at the time of entry. Any entrant may withdraw and have his/her entrance fee refunded provided notification is received 7 days prior to the tournament. Entries must be endorsed by the secretary or officer of the entrants club or by the resident PGA member in the case of public golf course players. The Tournament Committee has the right to refuse the entry of any person for the event without being required to give a reason for doing so.

**TIES:** In the event of a tie for the gross winner of the division a play-off will occur as decided by the Tournament Committee, until a winner is determined. All other winners will be decided utilising the Australian Count back System.

**PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT:** All entrants assent to be bound by the Code of Conduct which is available at [www.golfwa.org.au/cms/technical/golf-etiquette/](http://www.golfwa.org.au/cms/technical/golf-etiquette/)

**DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES:** Devices measuring distance only will be permitted during the tournament.

**DRESS REGULATIONS:** Dress code of Nedlands Golf Club must be observed.

**SUNSMART:** All players are to protect against the sun, wear eye protection, hats, caps, use sun screen SPF 30 + and drink ample water to avoid dehydration.
