CONDITIONS OF ENTRY WOMEN'S SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIP

1. Eligibility

- **1.1** Any amateur female golfer who has attained the age of fifty five on the twentieth day of March 2015.
- Each competitor must be a member of a club affiliated with Golf WA and hold a current Australian handicap. Eastern States competitors must be a member of a club affiliated with the applicable state body and hold a current Australian handicap. Overseas entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Championship Committee.

2. The event will be played in two sections.

2.1 The Championship

The Championship will be played over <u>36 holes of stroke play</u> over consecutive days and is open to any player eligible by way of 1.2 above. The first round will be played on Thursday, March 19 (pm) and the final round on Friday, March 20 (am). The winner of the Championship will be the player who records the lowest thirty six hole gross total.

In the event of a tie for the winner a sudden death play off will occur.

In the event of a tie for the leading Western Australian player a sudden death play off will occur. In the case of other ties the Australian Countback System will be used.

3. Trophies

- 3.1 Gross and Nett Winner and Runner-Up trophies will be awarded.
- 3.2 The leading Gross Western Australian player will represent Western Australia and be paid expenses to play in the 2015 Australian Amateur Women's Seniors Championship at Gosnells Golf Club (WA) from 26 30 October.

Should the state winner be unable to participate then the runner up will play in her place.

4. Field Size

The overall field size will be restricted to ninety six players. Should entries exceed this number then the highest handicapped players will be balloted.

5. Motorised Golf Carts

The Golf WA motorised golf carts policy will apply. Copies of this are available from clubs, the Golf WA Office or on the website http://www.golfwa.org.au/guests/about/policies/motorisedcarts.mhtml.

6. Player Code of Conduct

All entrants assent to be bound by the Golf WA Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available at http://www.golfwa.org.au/guests/about/policies/codesofconduct.mhtml

7. The Championship Committee

- 7.1 The Championship Committee will consist of the Chairperson of the Golf WA Golf Management Committee, members of the Golf Management Committee, the Golf Operations Manager together with any members of the host club that may be co-opted to serve on the Championship Committee.
- **7.2** The Championship Committee reserves the right to vary any of the Championship Conditions.
- 7.3 In the absence of the full Championship Committee, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision and any decision so given shall be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Committee.
