CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. ELIGIBILITY

The event is open to Junior Boys & Junior Girls amateur golfers who are **under 18 years old on 7th April 2015** and have an Australian Handicap with an affiliated club or GolfWA/GMJGF.

2. MATCH COMMITTEE

- 2.1 The Club Match Committee and Junior Committee will have sole management and control of the event.
- 2.2 In the absence of the above, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full committee.
- 2.3 The Committee's Match Policy and decisions on matters affecting the event will be final.
- 2.4 The decision of the Club Match Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.

3. RULES OF PLAY

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Rules Limited, will apply together with the Local Rules of the club.

4. ENTRIES

- 4.1 Entries will be subject to the approval of the entrants home club.
- 4.2 Entrants must conform in all aspects to the Rules of Amateur Status, as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Rules Limited.
- 4.3 A fully completed entry form together with the applicable entry fee must be received no later than Monday 30th March 2015.
- 4.4 In the event of entries exceeding the number of places available entries from those higher handicap competitors will be decided by ballot. Unsuccessful entrants will be given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Entrance fees will be refunded to entrants balloted out, who do not compete.
- 4.5 Entrance fees will only be refunded in the case of a withdrawal being received 48 hours prior to the day of the event.

5. THE EVENT

- 5.1 The event will be played over 18 holes of stroke play.
- 5.2 Lakelands Country Club reserves the right to alter Age Divisions depending on entry numbers.
- 5.3 Players may only win one major trophy.
- 5.4 Slow Play will not be tolerated (Maximum time per 9 holes is 2 hours and 15 mins)
- 5.5 No nomination will be accepted without entry fee.
- 5.6 In the event of there being a tie for the overall gross winner of the event, a sudden death playoff will take place to determine the winner. All other ties will be decided by using the Australian Count Back System.
- 5.7 The Lakelands CC Junior Open title will be awarded to the best gross score of the day, whether the player is a male or female.

6. PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

All entrants assent to be bound by the Golf WA Code of Conduct. A copy of the code is available at www.golfwa.com.au

7. TEE OFF TIMES

Rule 6-3a provides: "The player shall start at the time laid down by the committee". The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However it is a condition of this event that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if a player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes of his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes in stroke play rounds and loss of the first hole in match play.

8. MEASURING DEVICES

In this competition a player may obtain distance information by using a global positioning system (GPS) device that measures distance only. If during a stipulated round a player uses any other distance measuring device or a GPS device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play eg. gradient, wind-speed, temperature etc. the player is in breach of Rule 14-3 for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional functions are actually used.

9. DRESS REGULATION
