Junior Open – 36 Holes Stroke

Conditions of Entry

1. ELIGIBILITY

- 1.1 The event is open to male and female amateur golfers under the age of 18 years as at 1 January 2015 whose Golf Australia Handicap does not exceed 27 strokes for boys and 30 strokes for girls as at the date of entry.

2. MATCH COMMITTEE

- 2.1 The Club Match Committee will have sole management and control of the event.
- 2.2 In the absence of the full Club Match Committee, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full committee.
- 2.3 The Match Committee's decision on matters affecting the event will be final. Protests must be made in writing and submitted to the Match Committee within 10 minutes of the conclusion of the days play.
- 2.4 The decision of the Club Match Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.
- 2.5 The Match Committee has the right to draw competitors in such manner as thought advisable; vary the conditions of play as may be deemed advisable; refuse the entry of any person; decide the method to be employed in the case of ties; penalise any competitor for slow play; shorten the event in the case of inclement or extreme weather, accept late entries and invite any person to compete in the tournament.

3. RULES OF PLAY

- 3.1 The Rules of Golf, as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Rules Limited, will apply together with the Local Rules of the Club.

4. ENTRIES

- 4.1 Entrants must conform in all aspects to the Rules of Amateur Status, as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Rules Limited.
- 4.2 Entries must be lodged via the tournament website with payment prior to 5.00pm on Monday 18 May.
- 4.3 In the event of entries exceeding the number of places available (84), entries from those higher handicap competitors will be decided by ballot. Unsuccessful entrants will be given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Entrance fees will be refunded to entrants balloted out who do not compete.
- 4.4 Entrance fees will only be refunded if a withdrawal is received 72 hours prior to the first round.
- 4.6 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the committee. Any such entry shall be subject to the application of a \$10.00 late fee (includes GST).

5. THE EVENT

- 5.1 The event will be played over 36 holes of stroke play.
- 5.2 The draw will be published by 4pm on Friday 22 May 2015.
- 5.3 In the event of there being a tie for the overall gross male winner or female winner of the event, a sudden death playoff will take place to determine the winner. All other ties will be decided by using the Golf Australia Count Back System.
- 5.4 Players are not permitted to use a caddy during a stipulated round. A caddy is one who carries or handles a player's clubs and one who assists the player in shot and club selection. A person that carries or provides a player with food and refreshments or assist in the search for golf balls is not considered a caddy. Parents, guardians and interested people are requested to stay at a discreet distance from the playing group unless absolutely required.

6. PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

- 6.1 All entrants assent to be bound by the Golf WA Code of Conduct. A copy of the code is available from the Golf WA website.

7. MOTORISED CARTS

- 7.1 It is a condition of this event that players are not permitted to ride in or on any form of motorised transportation during a stipulated round unless authorised by the Committee. Exception: A player listed on the Golf WA Motorised Cart – Authorisation List published on the Golf WA website.

8. DRESS REGULATION

- 8.1 The Club's dress regulations will be enforced during the event for Players at all times and spectators using the Clubhouse. Further details will be distributed with the draw.
