## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

### 1. ELIGIBILITY

The event is open to male amateur golfers with official Australian Handicap as at the date of entry. Hcp limit – 18.

### 2. MATCH COMMITTEE

2.1 The Club's Match Committee will have sole management and control of the event.

2.2 In the absence of the full Club Match Committee, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full committee.

2.3 The Match Committee's decision on matters affecting the event will be final.

2.4 The decision of the Club's Match Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.

### 3. RULES OF PLAY

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Rules Limited, will apply together with the Local Rules of the Club.

Slow play will not be tolerated (max time for nine holes is 2 hrs 15 mins)

### 4. ENTRIES

4.1 Entries will be subject to the approval of the entrant's home club.

4.2 Entrants must conform in all aspects to the Rules of Amateur Status, as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Rules Limited.

4.3 A fully completed entry form together with the applicable entry fee must be received no later than 5pm Tuesday, 7th April 2015.

4.4 In the event of entries exceeding the number of places available, entries from those higher handicap competitors will be decided by ballot. Unsuccessful entrants will be given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Entrance fees will be refunded to entrants balloted out, who do not compete.

4.5 Refunds will only be given at the discretion of the Club's Match Committee.

### 5. THE EVENT

5.1 The event will be played over 36 holes of stroke play over two days.

5.2 The schedule of the event will be as follows; Round 1 – Sat, 11th April 2015, Rd 2 – Sun, 12<sup>th</sup> April 2015.

NB: Players eligible for the Paxton Averages will play on the same side of the draw.

5.3 In the event of there being a tie for the overall gross winner of the event, a sudden death playoff will take place to determine the winner. All other ties will be decided by using the Australian Count Back System.

### 6. PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

All entrants assent to be bound by the GolfWA's Code of Conduct. A copy of the code is available at [www.golfwa.org.au](http://www.golfwa.org.au)

### 7. TEE OFF TIMES

Rule 6-3a provides: "The player shall start at the time laid down by the Committee". The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However it is a condition of this event that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if a player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes of his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes.

### 8. MOTORISED CARTS

### 9. PRACTICE

One complimentary practice round will provided on Friday, 10<sup>th</sup> April 2015 to players eligible for the Paxton Averages. Bookings must be made by calling the Pro Shop on 9306 1122

### 10. DRESS REGULATION

- Neat and tidy dress with either tailored trousers or tailored shorts of suitable length (not high cut or below knee) which must be worn with belt at all times.
- Long, white walk socks or short predominantly white sports socks are permitted. White ankle socks are permitted.
- Shirts must have a collar and be neatly tucked into waistbands at all times.
- Turtle neck shirts must have a collar height of no less than 4 cm.
- Golf shoes and socks must be worn on course at all times.

Only entries submitted on this entry form, fully completed and accompanied by the correct entrance fee will be accepted.
