CONDITIONS

- 1. Open to financial male amateur golfers affiliated with a financial Country Club in Western Australia (with this being their Home Club). They must also play the majority of their golf in country areas. The GC reserves the right to use their discretion in this matter.
- 2. Entrants **must** have an official GA handicap of 36.4 or less (except when otherwise stated).
- 3. Entries **must** be submitted by clubs on the official entry form. No individual entries will be accepted.
- 4. The Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of the host club apply.
- 5. Order of play in the Foursome championship to be changed for the second eighteen holes.
- 6. THE DRESS REGULATIONS OF EACH HOST CLUB MUST BE COMPLIED WITH. PLEASE NOTE THONGS OR OPEN SHOES ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE AT ANY HOST CLUB.
- 7. In the event that the number of entries for Events 3 and 6 exceed the maximum field size, a ballot based on handicap will occur. Any player(s) balloted from an event will be placed in event 2 or 5 respectively.
- 8. In the event of a tie for first place in Events 3 and 6, a sudden death playoff will occur (time permitting). All other ties will be decided using the Australian Count-back system.
- 9. Players retain the same handicap for the 36 hole stroke play championship.
- 10. A player may not win more than one trophy in any given competition.
- 11. **Motorised carts**, if available for hire, may be used by any player and are on a first-come-first-served basis, however priority will be given to those who have GolfWA authorisation. Players are responsible for booking carts directly with the host clubs and organising payment.
- 12. **Player Code of Conduct** All entrants assent to be bound by GolfWA's Code of Conduct. A copy of the code is available at (www.golfwa.org.au).
- 13. Protests must be lodged with the Tournament Committee no later than ten minutes after completion of each round or match.

GolfWA reserves the right to vary the conditions of play in any way found necessary without assigning any reason thereto.
