

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Open to all financial female members of golf clubs affiliated with GolfWA with GA handicaps 21.9 and under.
2. Should a player's handicap increase to above the maximum after time of entry she must play off her revised handicap.
3. Players will retain the same handicap for the 36 holes.
4. No player may win more than one trophy in each competition (excluding teams' event, perpetuals, and novelties).
5. Entry fees are forfeited and non-transferable once the draw has been published.
6. Entry fees, dinner, and cart monies must accompany the entry form.
7. The Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews shall apply together with the Local Rules as drawn up by the Tournament Committee.
8. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to vary any of the Conditions.
9. Motorised Golf Carts are permitted to be used by any player providing they are available. Players listed on GolfWA's Authorised Users List will have preference to those available, followed by players in the order in which completed entries are received. Carts must be booked and paid for via GolfWA only.
10. The whole course and club house are SMOKE FREE. This includes e-cigarettes and vaping.
11. The draws will be posted on the GolfWA website by COB on Friday 28th June 2024.
12. Drug Testing: All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Drug Agency for banned substances as laid down in the Golf Australia Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy or refusing to take a test may be disqualified. A copy of the policy is available at www.golfaustralia.org.au
13. Player Code of Conduct: All entrants assent to be bound by the GolfWA Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available on the GolfWA website www.golfwa.org.au
14. All ties will be decided by a count back.
15. Players must comply with advice from the Australian Government's Department of Health, the State Government's Department of Health, Golf Australia (GA) and GolfWA regarding the COVID-19 virus and all requirements of the host club.
16. Entries close 5pm Wednesday 26th June 2024.
17. **COVID-19** Players must comply with any COVID-19 vaccination policy in place at the time of the competition set by the State Government and/or host venue. Note: requirements may change on short notice.
 - Participants and supporters must comply with any COVID-19 health directives, including:
