

## **Golf Western Australia Men's Pennant Finals**

In the event that any weather conditions or bad light as determined by GolfWA prevent any individual matches in a Pennant Final being played to their conclusion, the following conditions will apply in order to determine a result, unless a definitive result has already been achieved as per the point 4.7 of the Consolidated Pennant Regulations:-

## 1. 36 Hole Finals: Divisions One, Two and Three

- 1.1 Should *all* individual matches be played to their 27<sup>th</sup> hole, the result of the contest will be based on the total individual matches won at the conclusion of 27 holes.
- 1.2 If *any* individual matches have not completed 27 holes, then the result of the contest will be based on the total individual matches won at the conclusion of 18 holes, provided *all* individual matches have completed 18 holes.
- 1.3 If after the conclusion of 27 holes or 18 holes, as described in 1.1 and 1.2 above, the contest is square i.e 3 ½ 3 ½ and play is unable to be resumed on that day, play will be resumed on a day and at a time to be determined by the GolfWA in consultation with the Host Club.
- 1.4 If *any* individual matches have not completed 18 holes, and play is unable to be resumed on that day, play will be resumed on a day and at a time to be determined by the GolfWA in consultation with the Host Club.

## 2. 18 Hole Finals: Divisions Four and above and Public Club

If *any* individual matches have not been completed to their conclusion, play will be resumed on a day and at a time to be determined by the GolfWA in consultation with the Host Club.
