All qualifying rounds for the below events must be played between
3rd March and 3rd August 2026

What is the...

Silver Spoon?

- Best Stroke Nett aggregate of any four Silver Spoon rounds (as stipulated by your club)
- One off entry fee of \$13 per person
- Each winner at club level receives a handmade silver spoon and an invitation to the state play-off (Play-off fee of \$20)
- State nett winner (of submitted club scores) has their name engraved on the May Stillman Trophy

International Bowl?

- Silver division – GA handicaps 21.4 and below, Bronze division - GA handicaps 21.5 – 45.4
- One off entry fee of \$3.50 per person
- Best Nett score (from both silver and bronze divisions) out of three stipulated rounds at your club receives an International Bowl badge. Badges to be bought by the clubs and cost \$9 each
- Club winner's names are submitted to Golf WA and the best overall scores (silver and bronze) from the state have their names engraved onto the International Bowl and receive a prize

Jubilee Foursomes?

- Foursomes stableford event with no handicap limit
- Clubs nominate a day on which to play this format and may then put forward the winning pair to compete in the state play-off
- No fee is required at club level, the winning pair pay \$42 to compete in the play-off
- There are grass and sand green divisions at the state play-off and the winners will have their names engraved on perpetual shields

Women's 4BBB Challenge?

- 4BBB Stableford (can be played in conjunction with a club event)
- One off entry fee of \$8 per person
- The top 25 scores from both country and city clubs are invited to compete in the state play-off
- The winners of the play off receive flights, accommodation and entry to the Women's Australian Open that year
