

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Open to all financial female members of golf clubs affiliated with GolfWA with GA handicaps 21.9 and under.
2. Should a player's handicap increase to above the maximum after time of entry she must play off her revised handicap.
3. Players will retain the same handicap for the 36 holes.
4. No player may win more than one trophy in each competition (excluding teams' event, perpetuals, and novelties).
5. Entry fees, meals and cart monies must accompany the entry form. Please refer to event page and relevant link for entry - [Provincial Championship](#)

Entries close Wednesday 15th July 2026 at 4pm. Withdrawals **MUST** be received in writing and refunds will be given at the discretion of GolfWA.

Withdrawals received after Friday 17th July 2025 will not receive a refund for their catering fees.

The draws will be posted on the GolfWA website.

6. The Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews shall apply together with the Local Rules as drawn up by the Tournament Committee.
7. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to vary any of the conditions at any time.
8. Motorised Golf Carts are permitted to be used by any player providing they are available. Players listed on GolfWA's Authorised Users List will have preference to those available, followed by players in the order in which completed entries are received. Carts must be booked and paid for via GolfWA only.
9. Drug Testing: All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Drug Agency for banned substances as laid down in the Golf Australia Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy or refusing to take a test may be disqualified. A copy of the policy is available at www.golfaustralia.org.au
10. Player Code of Conduct: All entrants assent to be bound by the GolfWA Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available on the GolfWA website www.golfwa.org.au
11. All ties will be decided by a count back.

12. SMOKING & CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL

Please note that GolfWA and the development of golf is supported by Healthway and GolfWA encourages all participants to follow healthy food and drink options. As such players and caddies are requested to refrain from smoking and/or consuming alcohol during a round. (Note: In addition to the more traditional forms of smoking, this policy is also considered to cover vaping and the like).

The Championship Play Committee may impose any penalty, where applicable. Their decision is final.
