



## **GolfWA Pennant Finals – Policy for Severe Weather and/or Bad Light**

*The following policies apply to the specific Pennant competitions in the event that severe weather conditions and/or bad light, as determined by GolfWA, prevent any individual matches in a Pennant Final from being played to their conclusion.*

*These conditions will apply in determining a result unless a definitive result has already been achieved in accordance with Clause 4.7 of the Consolidated Pennant Regulations.*

### **Men's Division 1-3, Women's Weekend Division 1 and Women's Weekday Division 1**

- The result may be determined based on the match scores at the conclusion of the last completed hole, provided all matches have completed a minimum of 9 holes.
- If the aggregate result is tied at 3½–3½ after 9 holes, the winner shall be determined by the result of the Number 1 match, followed by the Number 2 match, and so on until a winner is determined.
- If no play occurs, or if all matches have not completed a minimum of 9 holes, the winner shall be the team that finished higher on the season ladder.

### **Men's Division 4-8 and Men's Senior 4BBB**

- The result may be determined based on the match scores at the conclusion of the last completed hole, provided all matches have completed a minimum of 9 holes.
- If the aggregate result is tied at 3½–3½ after 9 holes, the winner shall be determined by the result of the Number 1 match, followed by the Number 2 match, and so on until a winner is determined.
- If no play occurs, or if all matches have not completed a minimum of 9 holes, the winner shall be the team with the higher season win percentage, to account for divisions that may contain differing numbers of teams and therefore differing numbers of rounds during the season.
- If the result remains tied, the winner shall be determined by comparing the season win percentage of the Number 1 player from each team, followed by the Number 2 player, and so on until the tie is resolved.
